Welcome Message from Principal:

Natalie Andersen, Dee Swarbrick and I will be attending mandatory professional development for Education Queensland next Tuesday. These types of days are always a concern because we are out of the school, but it is essential we attend as it's a great opportunity for us to reflect on the current circumstances, what has been successful and what needs to change. It is also important that we get to communicate and share with other leaders and observe strategies that other schools are using.

Please remember at this school that an Open-Door Policy is an important part of our school culture so please let us know if you need to make an appointment with teachers or administration regarding any concern or question. We believe that collaborative communication is essential and really appreciate the input from parents. We are very aware that parents understand their child better than anyone and we often benefit from your input.

At the P&C meeting on Monday night I shared data relating to where we are at for our 2025 Annual Implementation Plan. I explained why as a school we are paying for additional swimming instructors and pool entry for all our students. We have taken the cost out of our school budget as the percentage of children drowning continues to rise across Australia. Please ensure that your child has sent in their forms so that we have 100 percent of our students attending these lessons. Please contact us if you have any issues regarding our swimming program.

So many of our students brought in their expressions of interest to go on our Maraka Float. There was so much interest that there are children who have unfortunately missed out being able to ride on the float, as we have to be extremely cautious for risk assessment purposes.

Our district RREAP funding is paying for our students to attend 'Fun with Maths' from the 27th to 29th of October. The small schools from around the district have also been invited to join us. There is also the possibility that we may have an author; Ian McIntosh visit us in Week 10. We will provide more information as soon as we have confirmation.

Don't forget to keep an eye on our Facebook Page and Newsletter this term for all these important updates on events and celebrations – relevant events like the Maraka Festival, Disco, Year 6 Graduation, Music Concert, and Transition days will be posted.

It is terribly hot now, so please remember to encourage your child to be wearing sunscreen whether at the pool or at school and reiterate the importance of continually drinking water throughout the day.

We really want all of our students at school every day. It is very difficult for any student to be able to gain an understanding of the concepts taught if they are continually missing school days, even one day a week missed makes a huge difference in a term. Learning is the key to so many future opportunities!

School Drop Off and Pick Up

It is important that our school remains safe and maintains hygienic environments for all of our community. Parents are asked to respect and adhere to the following measures:

- Students who are unwell must stay home.
- ❖ Parents are to use **MP Hall** area or **STOP**, **DROP & GO** area to drop students off in the morning. There will be supervision from 8.00am. Please do not congregate in/around school grounds to limit transfer of illnesses.
- Students can be collected from the STOP, DROP & GO area or BACK GATE area. Prep students will wait in the MP Hall each afternoon with their teachers.
- Please organise with your students where pick up will be. If situations change, please contact the office prior to 2:15pm to get a message to your child's classroom. Messages after 2.30pm may not be delivered in time.

Student Absences

If your child is absent from school, please advise via the following methods:

Please ensure you include your CHILD'S NAME/ CLASS/ DATE/ and the <u>REASON FOR THE ABSENCE</u>. If no reason is provided, the absence will be recorded as "Unexplained". If your child is absent for 3 or more days without reason, you will be contacted by the office.

LATE ARRIVALS

All students arriving late (after 8:40am) to School MUST present to the Office and collect a Late Arrival Slip before going to class. Please try to have your students on time for school.

EARLY DEPARTURES

If you are collecting your child from school early, you MUST attend the Office and sign the Early Departure Register. Your child will then be asked to meet you at the Office. If possible, please advise your child's teacher and the Office beforehand, especially when children are being collected at lunch times.

IMPORTANT

If you are arranging for someone other than yourself to pick up your child from School, **ONLY** people you have listed as an **EMERGENCY CONTACT** may do so. Please visit the Office to complete the relevant paperwork to update your child's record. Changes to emergency contacts must be done in person – we cannot take this information over the phone.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENT ATTENDANCE

- ❖ Parents are welcome on the school grounds; however, it is difficult to have parents in classrooms before school. If you wish to participate in class volunteering, please present to the office to make arrangements and sign in as a visitor.
- Mornings and afternoons are very busy times for teachers. If you have anything you wish to discuss with teachers, please make an appointment to ensure that any concerns/issues can be discussed.




